An online Public Meeting followed by an online Public Hearing with the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Water Resources Division (WRD), is being held to seek additional public input on the proposed New Use discharge permit to Red Equities, LLC for the Arbor Preserve Wastewater Treatment Plant. This meeting and hearing will be held on July 1, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. This event is being held virtually per Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners Resolution.

EGLE proposes to issue a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to Red Equities, LLC for the Arbor Preserve Wastewater Treatment Plant located northeast of the intersection of West Waters Road and South Wagner Road, Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan 48103. The applicant proposes to discharge treated sanitary wastewater to an unnamed tributary to Rouse Drain.

Major topics being discussed include proposed effluent limitations and the regulation of the design and operation of the proposed treatment plant.

The proposed permit was on public notice from March 19, 2021 through April 18, 2021.

All interested parties are invited to present comments on the proposed NPDES permit. Persons unable to attend the public meeting and/or hearing may submit comments through July 9, 2021.
