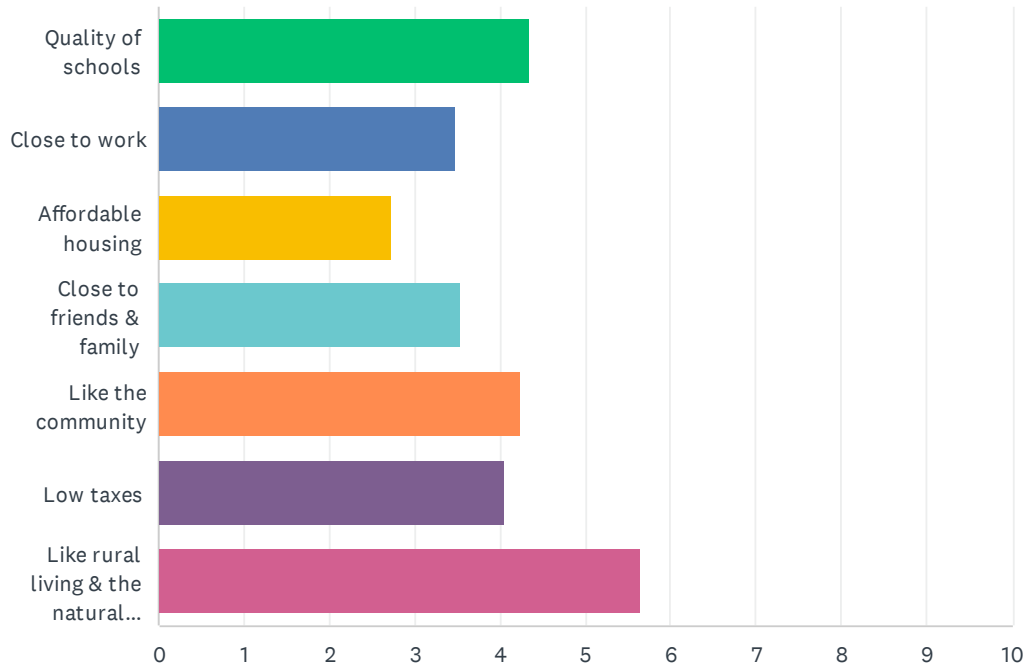


Q1 Which of the following are reasons that you live in Lodi Township? Please rank the following.

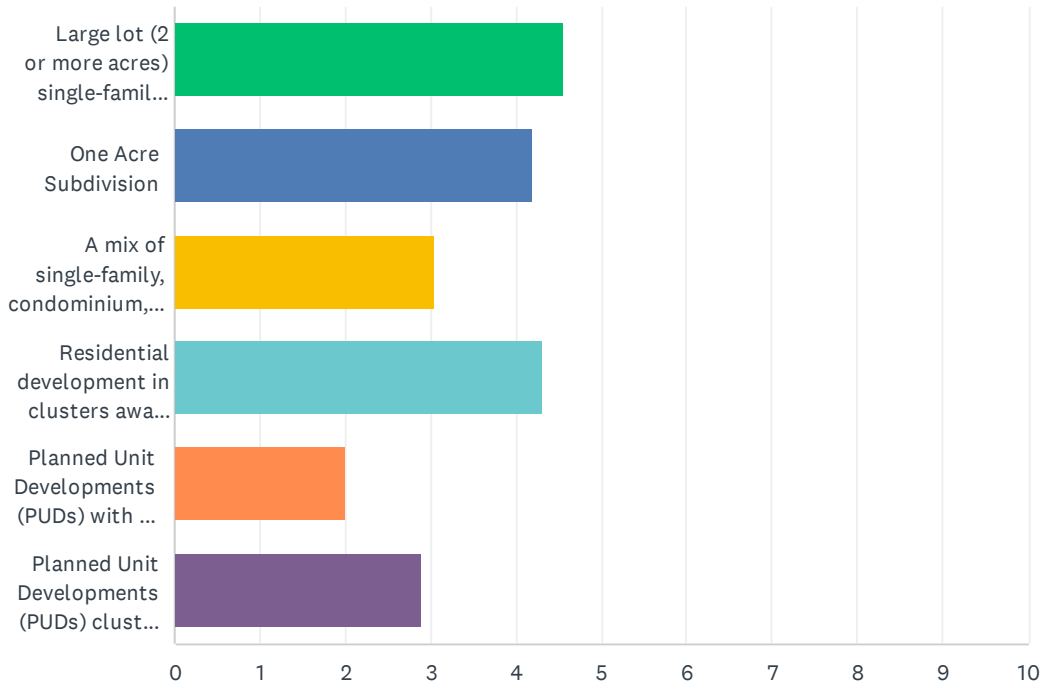

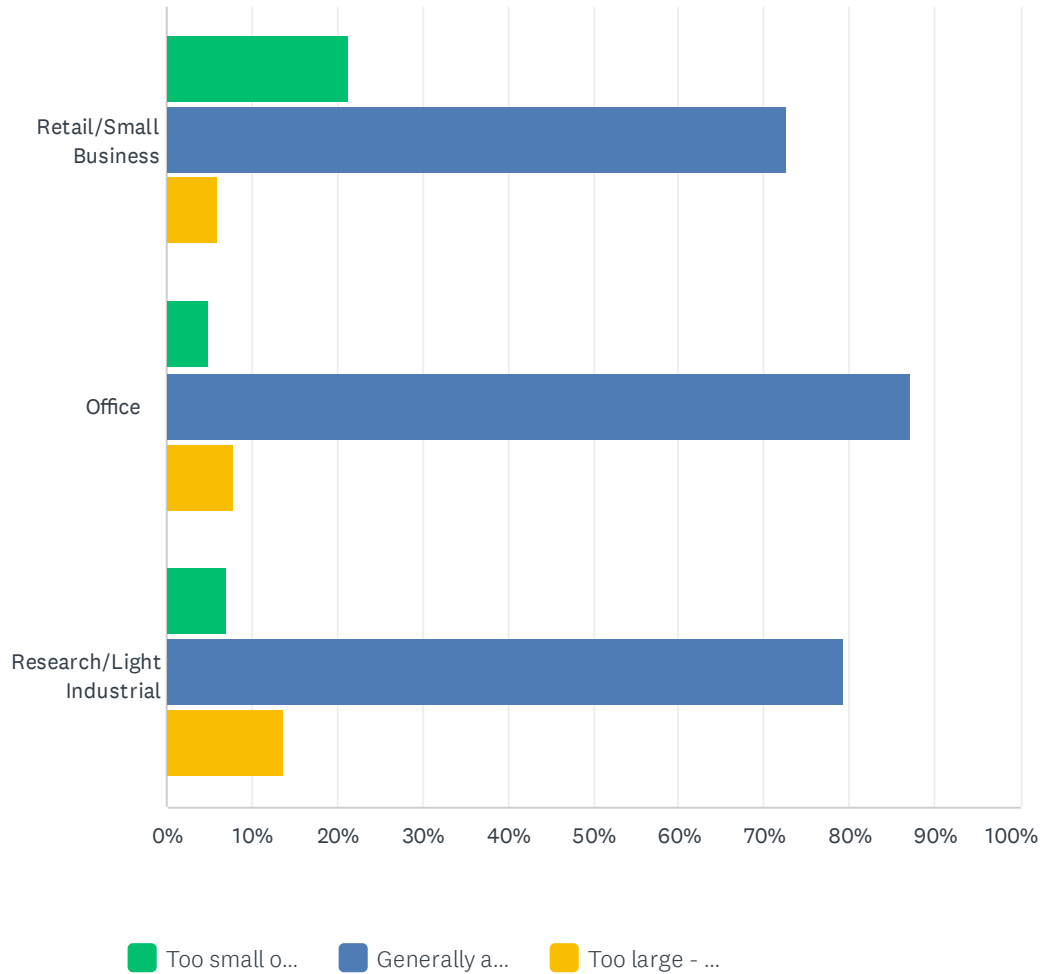

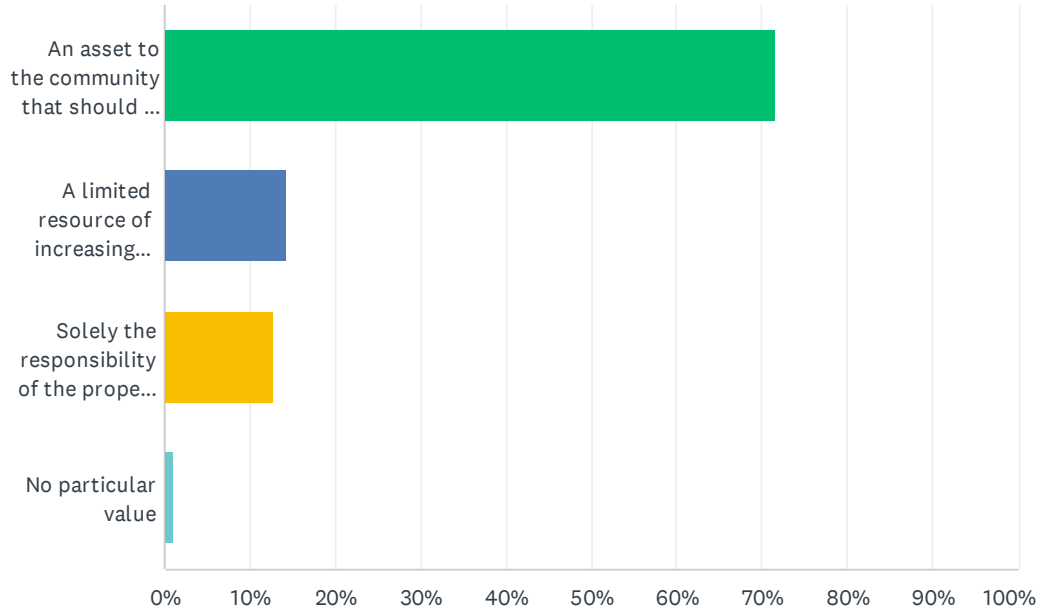

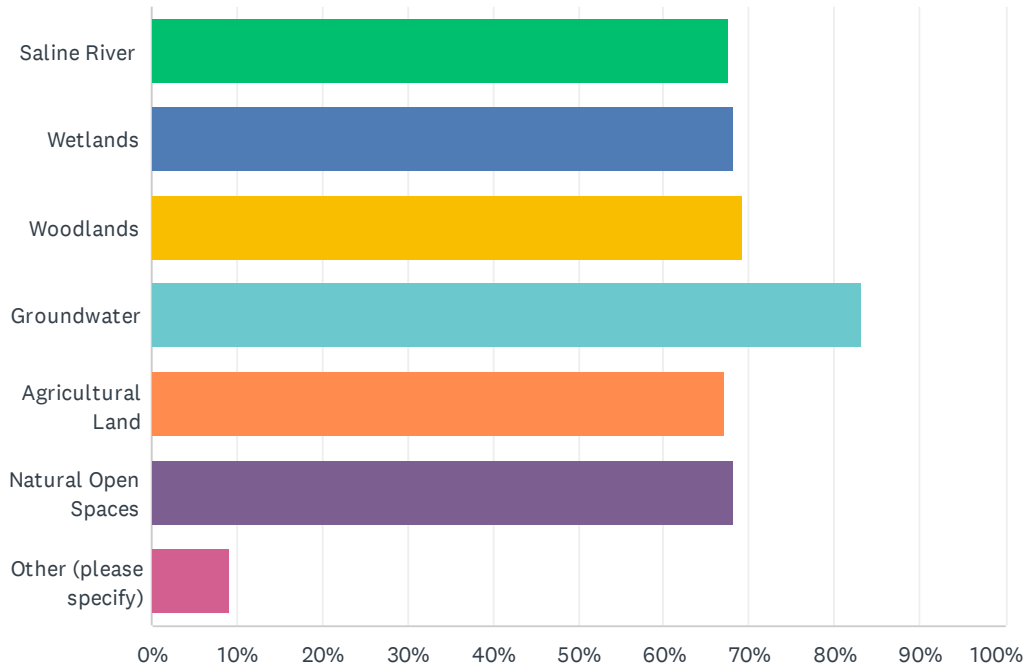

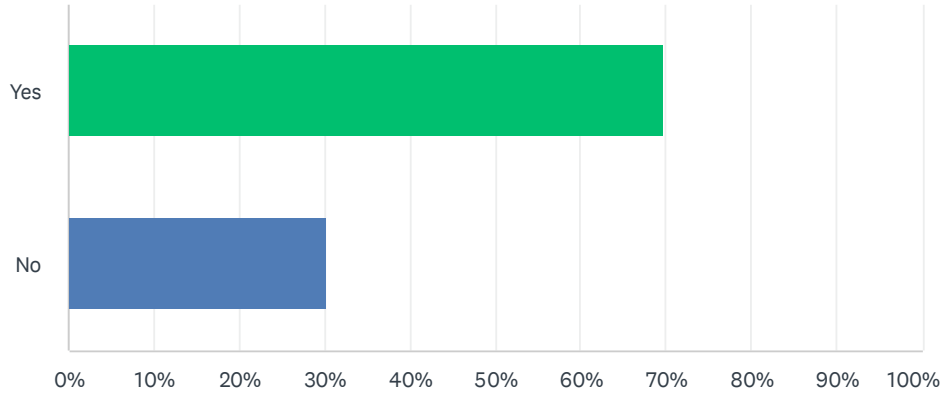

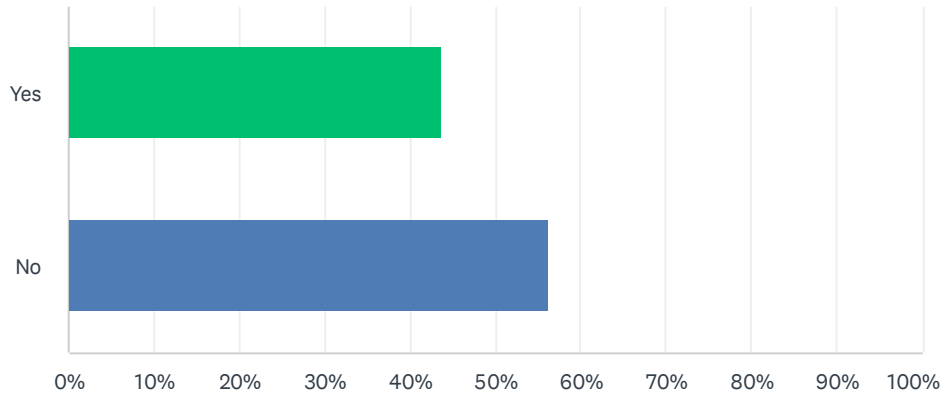

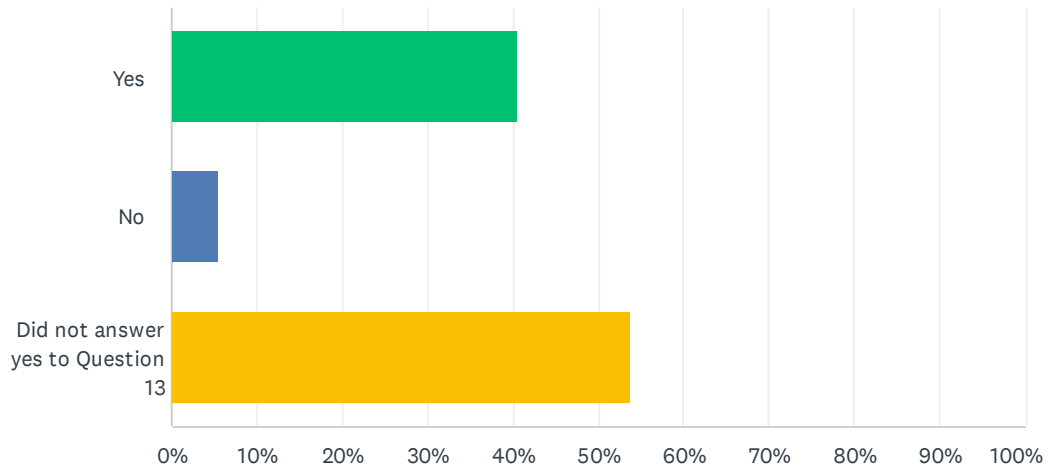

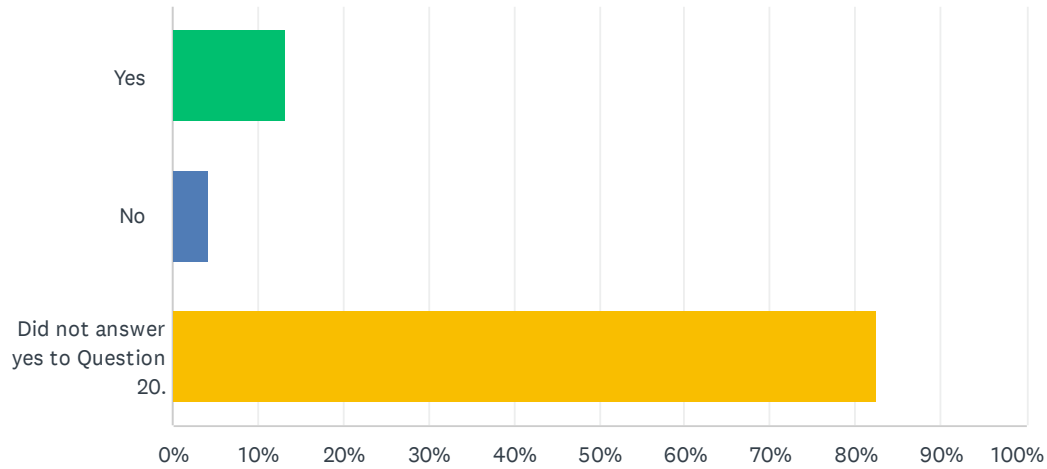

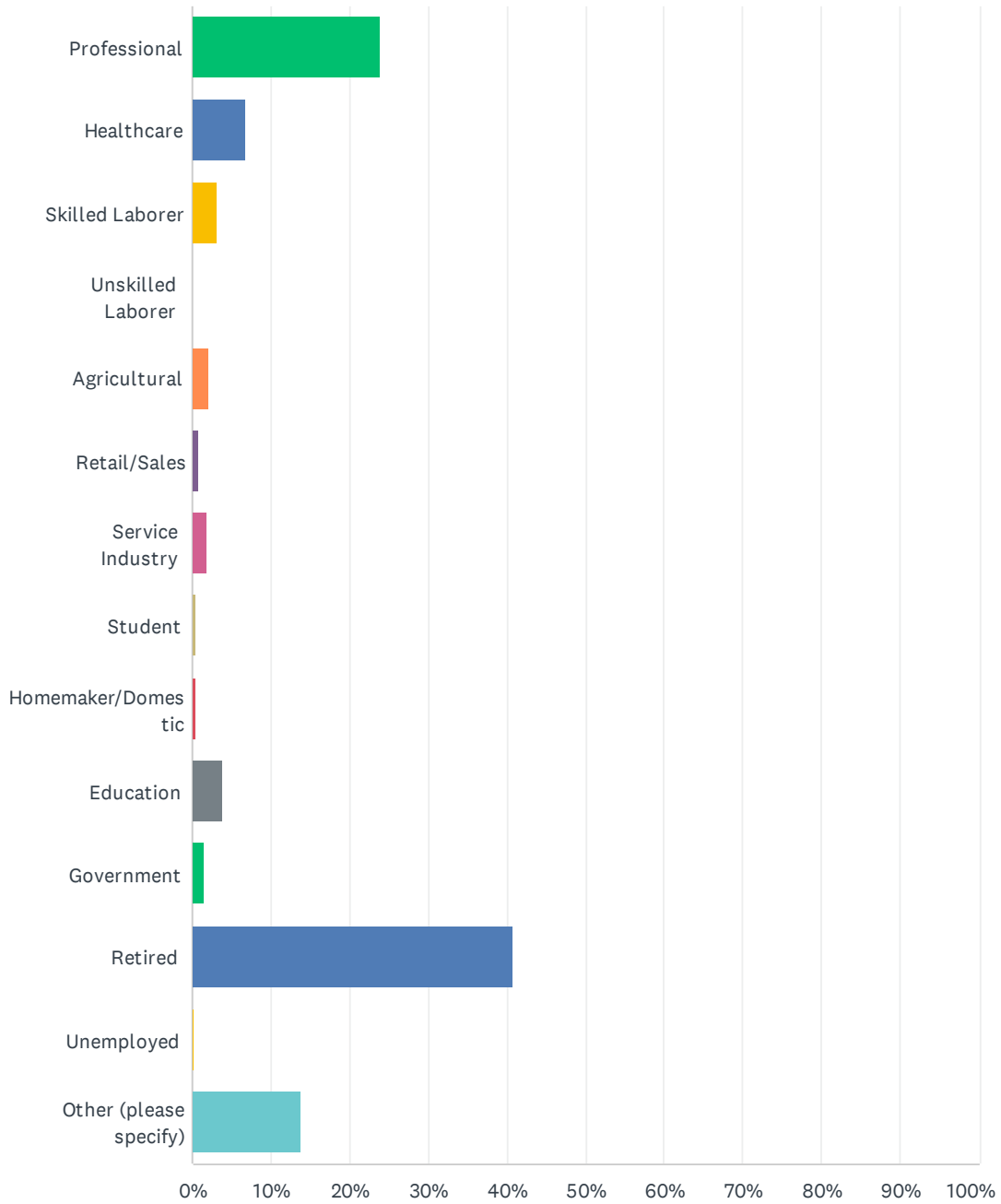

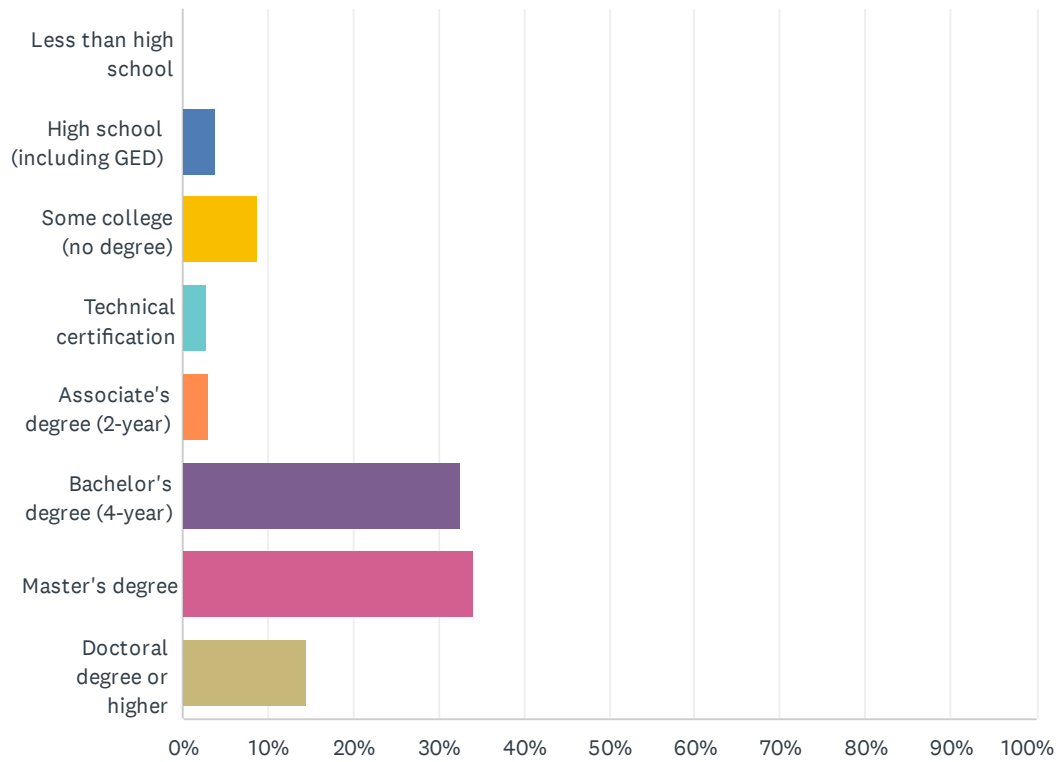

Q37 What is your highest level of education completed?

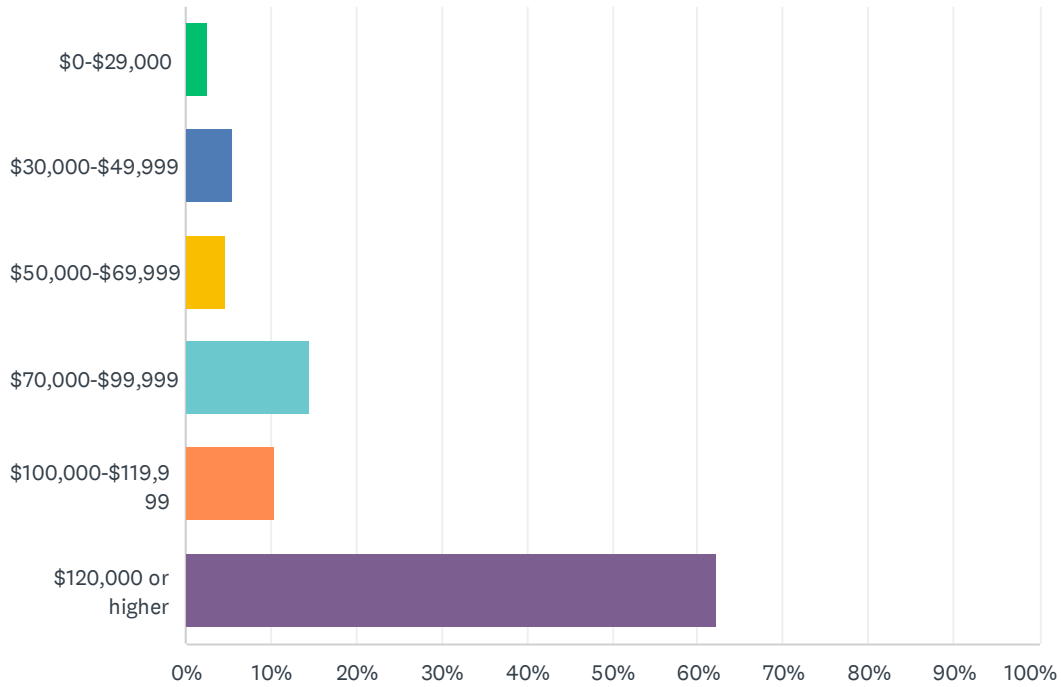
